

**Day 7- Praying for All Saints Everywhere**

**Praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all saints. Ephesians 6:18**

We have to understand what is going on here. If we believe in the existence of our heavenly Father, why do we ignore the fact that satan is just as real and must be dealt with. He will not go away simply because we ask him to. Saints, we must wrestle to regain our loved ones from the clutches of the devil.*

*Father, in the name of Jesus, we ask that you forgive us for our sins. Cleanse us from all unrighteousness as we bow before your throne. We praise you, oh God, for who you are. We magnify your name and give you all honor and glory.*
